Mediation (JAN)	ESV	Joshua 1:8	8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.
Prayer (FEB)	NIV	Ephesians 6:18	18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.
Fasting (MAR)	ESV	Matthew 6:17-18	17 But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, 18 that your fasting may not be seen by others but by your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.
Study (APR)	ESV	Romans 12:2	2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.
Simplicity (MAY)	ESV	Galatians 6:14	14 But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.
Solitude (JUN)	ESV	Mark 1:35	35 And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, He departed and went out to a desolate place, and there He prayed.
Submission (JUL)	ESV	Luke 9:23	23 And He said to all, "If anyone would come after Me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow Me."
Service (AUG)	ESV	Mark 10:45	45 "For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many."
Confession (SEP)	ESV	1 John 1:9	9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
Worship (OCT)	ESV	John 4:24	24 God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.
Guidance (NOV)	ESV	Matthew 18:20	20 "For where two or three are gathered in My name, there am I among them."
Celebration (DEC)	ESV	John 15:11	11 "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full."
